## ISSN

Type in 7 digits of your ISSN. The last check digit will be calculated by the script. The number will be output in this format: #####-####.

## ISBN

The script is aware of both current 10 digit ISBN and the new (in use from January 1, 2007) 13 digit numbers.

Enter 9 (or respectively 12) digits of your ISBN. The last check digit will be calculated by the script. The number will be output in this format: #####-# or #####-#. Adjusting formatting of the number to suit your specific needs can be made possible for a small additional fee.

## EAN-13

Enter 12 digits of your EAN. The last check digit will be calculated by the script. You can optionally select adding ">" (so called *Quiet Zone Mark*) at the end of the code. It is also possible to adjust the height of the code. By default it is 50 per cent.

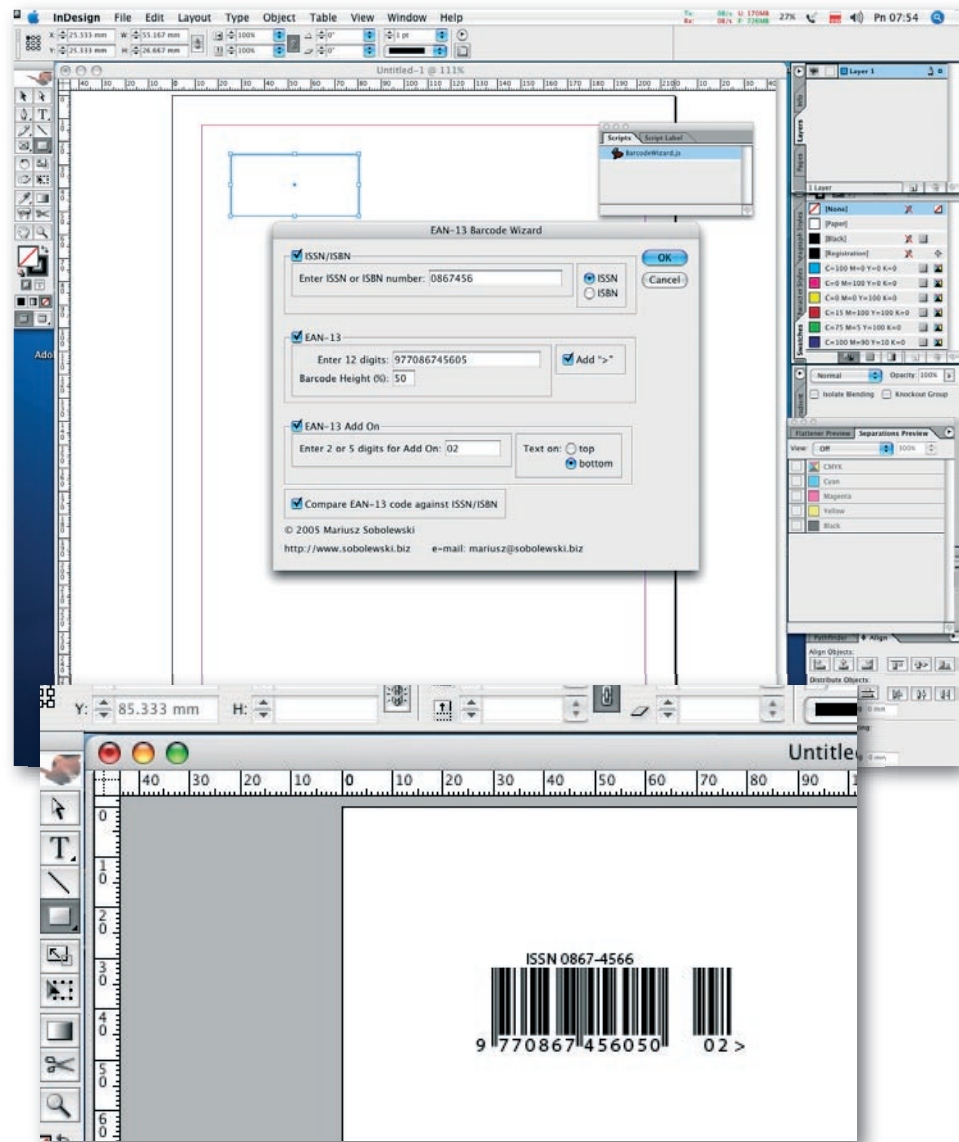
## Add On

Optionally you can choose to add additional information next to the barcode, e.g. the issue number. Both 2 and 5 digit add ons can be used. You can also select whether you want add on text to appear on top or below the add on bars.

1. Draw a rectangle to define the area in which you want to fit the barcode.
  - \* If the area's aspect ratio will be such that it will be taller than wider, the barcode will be placed rotated by 90°.
2. Click the script's name, enter all the necessary values, and press "OK".
3. The barcode will appear in the selected area except it will be placed on a new layer named "Barcode". By default this layer is locked for editing. Two new paragraph styles will also appear in your document: "Barcode Digits" and "ISSN/ISBN text". You can adjust their properties to your needs. The default font is Myriad Pro. The recommended font for ISBN is OCR-B.
